Colonial Baptist Church Announces Name Change to “The Shepherd’s Church”

Cary, NC – Colonial Baptist Church, which was founded 34 years ago by Pastor/Teacher Stephen Davey, closes out 2020 with an exciting announcement. Beginning January 1, 2021, their new name will be “The Shepherd’s Church.”

Pastor Davey states, “While we’ve always been a church devoted to Bible exposition and the Chief Shepherd of the church – Jesus Christ – our name now clearly identifies to Whom we belong and to Whom we serve.”

Colonial Baptist Church has had a rich history in the community dating back to 1986 and has been blessed tremendously, growing from a handful of people meeting in East Cary Middle School to a beautiful 30-acre campus with ministries impacting several thousand households. Over the years, the church has launched a special family of partner ministries whose names all revolve around the Lord – our Shepherd: Shepherds Theological Seminary, Shepherds 360, Shepherds International, and Shepherds Network. The new church name brings about further clarity and consistency moving forward. While the name may have changed, the mission and message has not.
